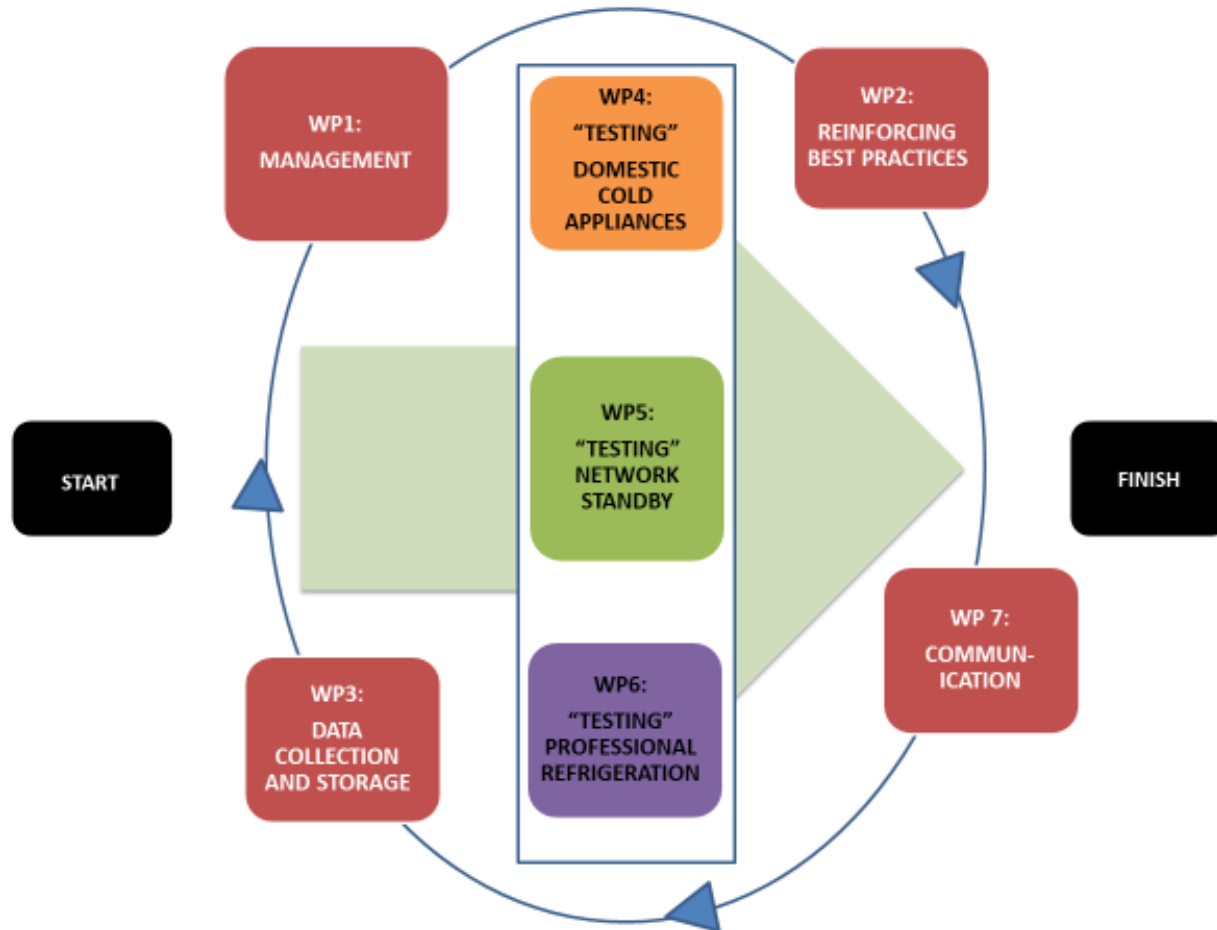
Work programme

EEPLIANT2 coordinates the monitoring, verification and enforcement activities of **17** market surveillance authorities (MSAs) across the Single Market.

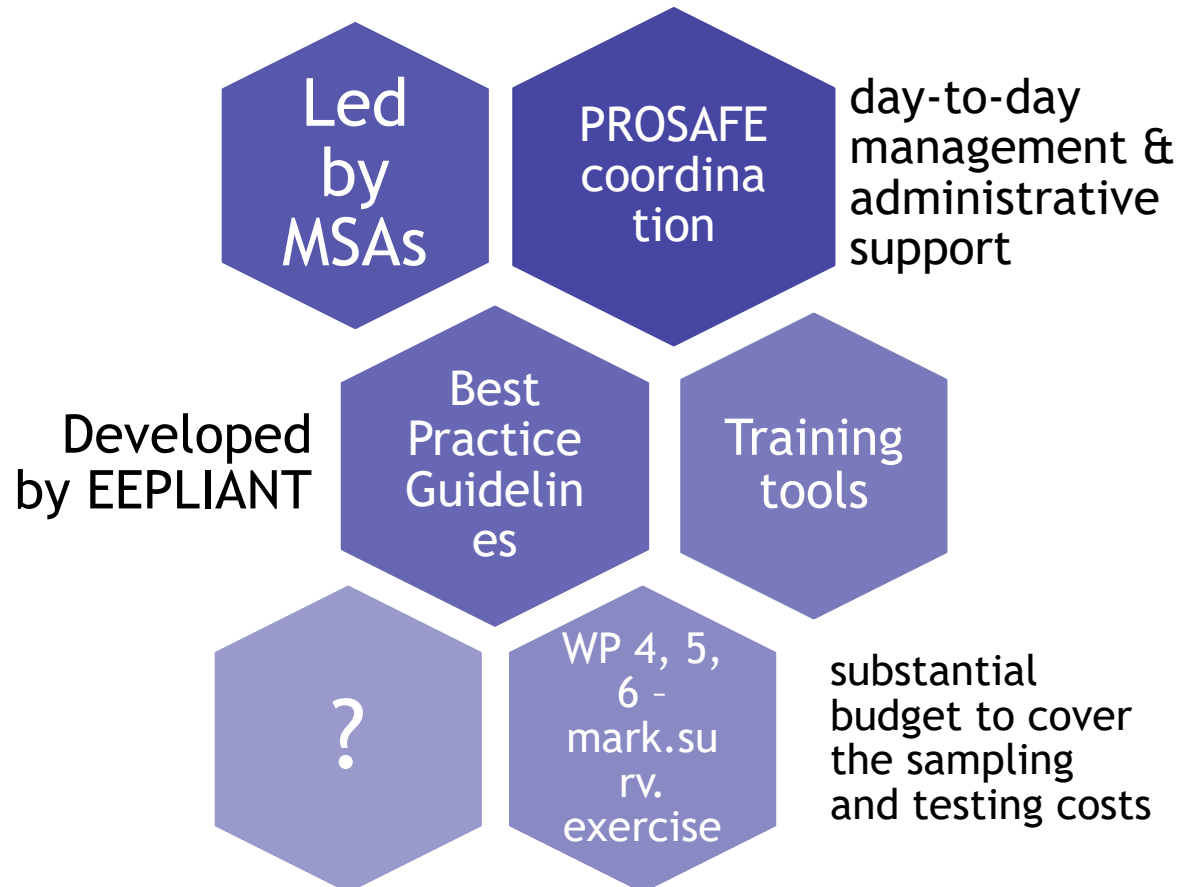
This will be done through the delivery of 7 Work Packages:

- WP1 - Management
- WP2 - Reinforcing Best Practices
- WP3 - Data collection and storage
- WP4 - Inspection and testing of domestic cold appliances
- WP5 - Inspection and testing of network standby
- WP6 - Inspection and testing of professional cold appliances
- WP7 - Communications

HOW it will operate

- The participating MSAs work together in meetings to agree on:
 - Their own in-shops label study;
 - Making documentation examinations for selected (via risk assessment) models;
 - Selecting and sending models for testing at the same laboratory used by all participants;
 - Agreeing and harmonising their enforcement actions on non-compliant products.

Project management and coordination - WP1

- Management Team have overall responsibility;
- Each WP is led by a beneficiary, preferably from a MSA, as this project's goal is effective market surveillance
- PROSAFE manages the project day-2-day:
 - Administrative support or not;
 - Pre-finance or reimbursement on a cost-occurring basis.
- Key to this management are the *Facilitators* who:
 - Supports the Work Package Leader by undertaking the organisational workload;
 - Provide the “glue” that holds the WP together.

Building capacity: WP2 and WP3

- WP2: Reinforcing and further developing best practices developed in EEPLIANT1 (www.eepliant.eu)
- WP3: Data management using IT to enter data directly into database and for onward transfer to ICSMS.

Dissemination



- The key route for dissemination is through ICSMS - the official results database accessible to all MSAs in the EU i.e. the results of EEPLIANT2 will potentially be shared with *all* EU MSAs.
- Ecodesign and Energy Labelling ADCO membership will be informed when results become available.
- Key findings from the results will be shared with the Advisory Board members.

Exploitation

- Enforcement action will be taken by the MSAs participating in EEPLIANT2 as non-compliances are detected;
- Results of these actions will be reported via ICSMS - so that other EU MSAs, who are not participating in EEPLIANT2, can also take enforcement action;
- Advisory Board members can share key findings with their membership - who may then take their own actions.

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
